

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(to be read in conjunction with the Disclaimer form)

- All horses undergoing hydrotherapy treatment at The Equine Therapy Centre @ Moulton College do so at their Owner's risk.
- Appointments cannot be fulfilled without the correct referral from the horse's Veterinary Surgeon.
- All horses using The Equine Therapy Centre @ Moulton College must be fully up to date with their vaccinations.
- All persons entering The Equine Therapy Centre @ Moulton College do so at their own risk and are advised to take extreme caution and not to position themselves between a horse and the swimming pool.
- All persons entering the Equine Therapy Centre @ Moulton College are required to wear non-slip footwear.
- Horses using the Aqua-Treadmill should not be freshly shod or have road nails. If freshly shod, please ask your farrier to file down the nails so that they are smoother and less abrasive to the treadmill belt.
- Horses undergoing Hydrotherapy Exercise should not be fed at least two hours prior to the appointment (hay is fine). Please clean up after your horse whilst on site.
- **Horses must be clean to use any of the Hydrotherapy Equipment to maintain water hygiene**
 - **As a minimum, feet must be picked out and scrubbed clean with legs washed**
 - **Horses will be washed all over prior to swimming to remove dirt & loose hairs**
- Horses using the Aqua-Treadmill or Spa will have their tail bandaged up by a member of Hydrotherapy Centre Staff. If due to health and safety reasons it would be preferable for you to do this yourself, please let us know!
- We must be advised if your horse's condition changes and your Veterinary Surgeon wishes for changes to be made to your horse's treatment programme.
- Cancellations without 24 hours' notice or missed appointments will be charged at the normal session price.
- Please try to be on time for your appointment and to make contact regarding your estimated time of arrival if held up. If late, you may have to wait for the next available appointment that day.
- We may from time to time take photographs of your horse undergoing therapy sessions to promote the Equine Therapy Centre; if you would rather we did not use any photos taken then please let us know.
